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Aims and objectives of the organisation

The objectives of the club are: -

- The promotion of junior football within New Cumnock and its surrounding environs;
- The advancement of public participation in sport involving physical skill and exertion:
- The provision and organisation of recreational facilities and activities for local people of New Cumnock and its environs:
- The advancement and promotion of a healthy lifestyle through the provision of physical activity:
- The advancement of citizenship and community development through encouraging and developing local volunteers in the development of the club, its purposes, facilities and activities: and
- Any other purpose that may be reasonably regarded as analogous to the preceding purposes.

Purpose of the grant (including breakdown of costs)

A grant of up to £17,970 is requested to appoint architects to provide detailed drawings for the proposed new community sports and wellbeing hub in New Cumnock.

A REF award of £11,040 was made to New Cumnock Community Council in June 2018 to support the cost of an options appraisal and feasibility study for a community sports hub at Loch Park, New Cumnock. Although the feasibility study has identified a proposed structure, the new community organisation who will deliver and manage the community sports hub has not yet been established. New Cumnock Development Trust are currently seeking expressions of interest from the community and will take forward the creation of the new organisation once a committee is established. As an interim measure, to help take the project forward and sustain local engagement, Glenafton Athletic football club have submitted the application for further project funding to appoint an architect to prepare detailed drawings for the new community sports hub.

Given the cost of the overall capital project, the group intend to invite architects who have submitted a design team tender to deliver a presentation to a panel who will make a decision on their proposal.

There has been occasional flooding on site but imminent flood prevention works will assist with this problem. Flooding considerations have also formed part of the early design discussions and a proposal to raise the football park slightly to allow the installation of sufficient drainage will be discussed in more detail with the architects procured to provide the detailed drawings.
